Grade 9

- Grade 9 students at Heritage follow a prescribed course of study, acquiring the credits required by the Ontario Ministry of Education. All Grade Nine students are required to take Bible (HRE13), Health & Physical Education (PPL1O), Art (AV1O5), and a half-credit course in Choir (AMU1O5)
- Grade 9 English, French, Geography, Mathematics and Science are also required courses and are offered at both the academic (D) and applied (P) level. The course content at Grade Nine level is similar in either stream; applied courses feature more “hands on” or practical activities while the academic courses are more theoretical.
- Students who can not take either French FSF1D or FSF1P may be enrolled, with the Principal’s permission, in GLS1O, a work/study skills course.
- HCS may sometimes combine classes of academic and applied. Please indicate your preference for either academic or applied streams in the chart below.

Grade 10 students follow 6 required (√) courses of study and 2.5 elective courses. Grade 10 English, History, Mathematics and Science offer credits at both the academic (D) and applied (P) level. French is offered only at the academic level.

Grade 11 students follow 3 required (√) courses of study: Bible, English (choose C or U) and Mathematics (choose C or U or E) and choose 5 electives to complete their schedule.

- If you choose Math in Semester 1 Period 1 you must choose WorldRel. in Semester 2, Period 1 and vice-versa.
- Indicate your choice of electives by placing a number in the appropriate box indicating 1st, 2nd, or 3rd choices.
- HCS may combine classes of university and college bound courses.
- Minimum enrolments will be required in order to offer courses.
- Period 3 courses are ½ credit full-year courses.
